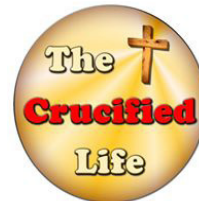
Confess your sin before God and place faith in the eternal spiritual work of God in your heart and you will be saved.

Matthew 7:13-14 (KJB) Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat: 14 Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.

The context of this scripture verse is about various gates found around the courtyard of the temple in ancient biblical times.

These multiple gates served individual purposes ranging from a place for taking out the trash, to significance for various tribes, and included a distinct narrow entrance leading exclusively inside to worship at the temple of God.

Those who desired to dwell inside the temple of God had to enter into the one and the only narrow passageway leading straight to God's temple. There was no another entrance way possible for meeting with God.

It was highly important for the people of every ancient city to recognize and understood where each of these individual gates and pathways in the city led. It is no different for us today in meeting God.

What about you, do you know where you are walking in this world and if it will lead to God in the eternal realm? You can be certain that every soul will have an eternal address upon physical death.

Yes, there are only two eternal addresses possible and each person is free to choose his own course. God will not horse collar any person into following His way. His pathway is the one paved by grace and the shed blood of Jesus Christ upon Calvary and always results in eternal life. The alternate avenue leads straight to Hell.

Both conduits, the wide thoroughfare and the narrow less trodden way, certainly leads every soul into an eternal existence of his or her own choosing. However, the addresses are in completely different eternal spiritual venues. one in the choir of Heaven and the other in the fiery pits of Hell.

One eternal existence will be joyful and jubilant; while the other will be found "on the other side of the spiritual tracks" and be forever excruciatingly painful and unpleasant.

Yes, every person will exist spiritually alive in eternal fellowship with God or exist spiritually dead without God forever.

The pathway you elect to follow in this world is up to you. However, eternity lasts forever and forever is a long time to be wrong, spiritually lost, and without God.
